

Journal of Trip to Lesueur National Park and Perenjori, September 2016

This was a 2-day trip on Saturday, 17-Sep-16 and Sunday, 18-Sep-16.

On Saturday, we drove North from Perth along the Indian Ocean Drive to Jurien Bay (240km). We had to make a significant diversion near Guilderton as there had been a serious accident and the road was blocked. We diverted via Gingin Brook Rd, Telephone Rd, Waterville Rd, Cowalla Rd, and Bennies Rd.

Stayed overnight in Jurien Bay Hotel Motel.

Sunday we drove a little distance from Jurien bay to the Lesueur National Park, and spent a couple of hours there.

Then drove North on Cockleshell Gully Road, then East (inland) on the Green Head to Coorow Road (stopping at Half Way Roadhouse (Warradarge) on Brand Hwy for lunch). Then on to Coorow, then Carnamah, then Perenjori. A total of 245 km.

We visited a remarkable location for Wreath Flowers 6.4km north of Perenjori towards Morawa, then 1.5km on Back Bowgada Road. Off the road on the Right, a gravel pit. Also some on the North side of Back Bowgada Road.

We then drove home, via Coorow, Watheroo, Moora, Mogumber, Bindoon, near Muchea, near Bullsbrook/Pearce, Neaves Road, Joondalup, arriving about 7pm. A total of 450km from Perenjori. We did look at overnight accommodation options in Watheroo and Moora, but Moora Motel had no Internet, so we decided just to drive home.
